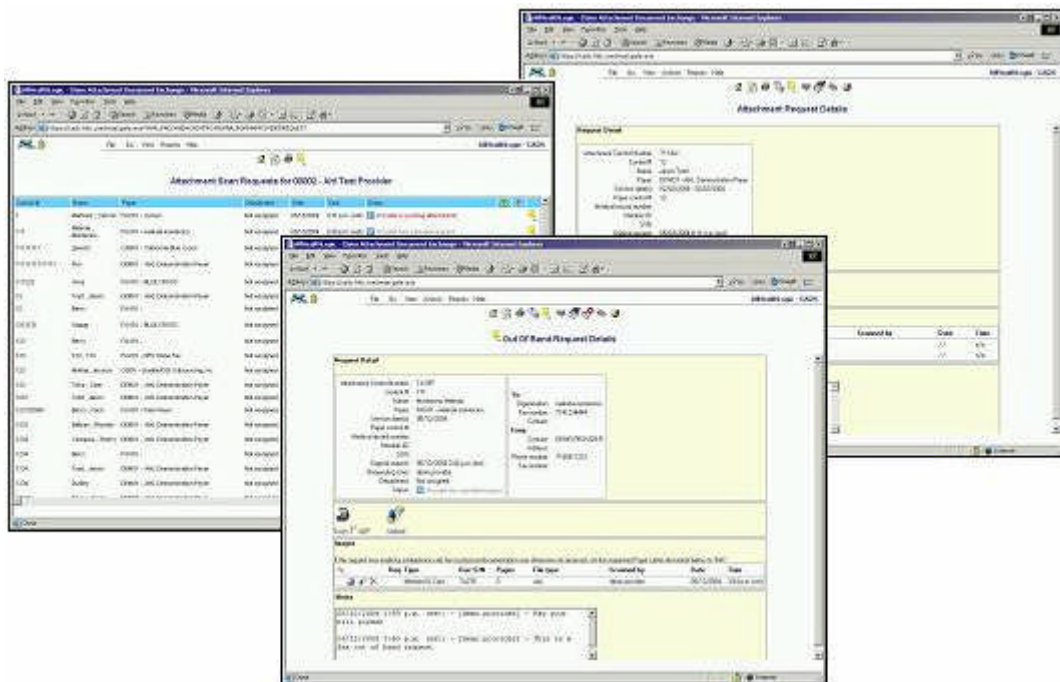




# Claim Attachment Document Exchange (CADX<sup>®</sup>)

CADX<sup>®</sup> was born through a collaborative process between providers and payers called the Business Policy and Process Improvement (BPPI) project developed by the Hospital Association of Southern California. The BPPI Project identified claim attachments as an area of major concern in the revenue cycle process that all team members experienced. The BPPI members developed the business concepts and worked with HealthLogic Systems Corporation to build a solution, CADX<sup>®</sup> (Claim Attachment Document Exchange).

CADX<sup>®</sup> was piloted by Blue Cross of California and three Southern California hospitals in 2001-2002. Since then, CADX<sup>®</sup> has been marketed nationally as a stand alone product and as part of HealthLogic's suite of revenue cycle management products. Claim attachments have always been a major problem for providers, and payers, alike. CADX<sup>®</sup> provides an electronic, HIPAA compliant solution for that problem.



HealthLogic has developed an innovative approach for Payers and Providers of all types to manage solicited or unsolicited attachment responses from providers and to assist them in the conversion of paper responses to e-documents.

Claims Attachment Document Exchange (CADX<sup>®</sup>) is available in three versions to support different business environments:

- CADX<sup>®</sup> “Hands Free” - creates batch transmissions for requests and/or responses via FTP or VPN
- CADX<sup>®</sup> “Interactive” - provides an HTML Browser version for manual requests and/or responses
- CADX<sup>®</sup> “Private Label” - provides a branded web site that can utilize both Interactive and Hands Free solutions

CADX<sup>®</sup> is a web based tool that enables the transfer of requests for information and the submission of that information to facilitate the review of healthcare claims. CADX<sup>®</sup> can be utilized in any Payer department, from claims, to appeals to utilization management and in any Provider department, from the business office to medical records to discharge planning departments. Requests received by any media may be entered, responded to by scanning, uploading or faxing, and completely managed on-line. The electronic documents are stored in the CADX<sup>®</sup>'s secure repository, and are delivered to the designated recipient electronically or by fax, whichever is mandated by the Payer.

CADX<sup>®</sup> does not require large purchases of capital equipment. CADX<sup>®</sup> users require only a standard PC, a scanner or fax machine, and Web access. All software and technology reside at HealthLogic Systems Corporation's EHNAC accredited clearinghouse maintained 24-7 with redundancy and backup. CADX<sup>®</sup> meets or exceeds all HIPAA requirements including the emerging attachments transaction rule.
